CCF Receives Grant from the Bama Works Fund of the Charlottesville Area Community Foundation

CHARLOTTESVILLE, VA— The Charlottesville/Albemarle Commission on Children and Families (CCF) has received \$5,100 to provide scholarships for disadvantaged youth to participate in summer camps and enrichment programs through its 2010 FUNd.

The program is administered by the Commission on Children and Families in partnership with the Family Support Workers of the Albemarle County Department of Social Services and Children, Youth and Family Services (CYFS).

In 2009, The Summer FUNd provided summer camp scholarships for approximately 21 Albemarle County children from low income families who were referred by Family Support Workers located in County Schools.

These scholarships would not be possible without the support of the **Bama Works Fund** of the Dave Matthews Band in the **Charlottesville Area Community Foundation**. This month more than 50 local organizations received grants from the Bama Works Fund in the CACF, a permanent endowment dedicated to improving the quality of life throughout Central Virginia.
