

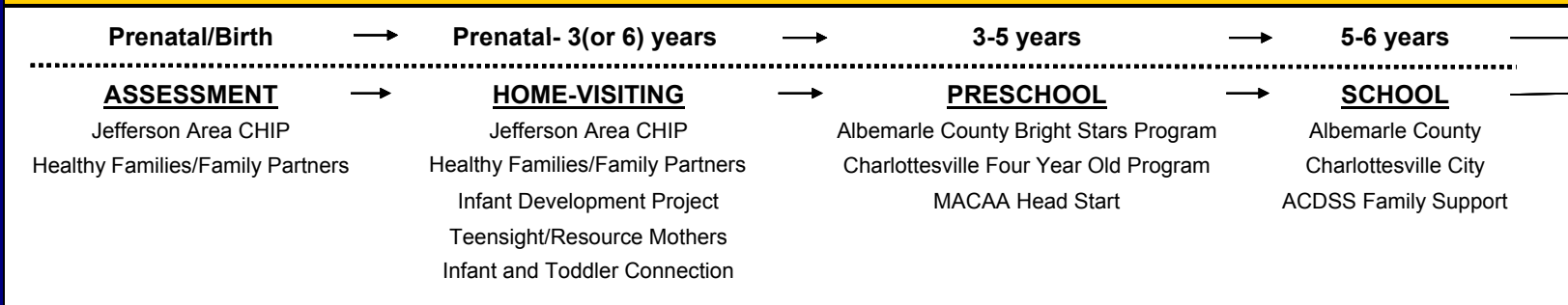


EARLY CHILDHOOD STRATEGY (0-6 YEARS)
